Once again, from the CNB, we want to invite all postdoctoral scientists who are working abroad to visit **Madrid** on **21st of December** and present their work at the conference **Advances in Molecular Biology by Young Researchers Abroad**, which is being organized in our centre.

For the last 26 years, this event has been held to coincide with Christmas so that young postdocs abroad can present their research to the Spanish scientific community.
